MINUTES

1. President Randy Kallstrom called the Caucus to order at 6:10 PM.
2. It was determined nominations would be cast by paper ballot. Motion made by Jesse Van Alstine, second by Shirley Seifert.
3. Clerk announced there will be three seats available for the position of Village Board Trustee in the upcoming Spring election. The seats are currently occupied by incumbents Shannon Van Allen, Vicki Kosok, and Goran Pesic. Shannon and Vicki will be running again. Goran will not.
4. It was determined by those in attendance that in the event of a tie, the tie would be broken by taking a vote.
5. Mary Meixner, Anne Murray, and Matt Bertelson were selected to pass out paper to the attendees for writing down their nominations. Toni Raethke was chosen to write down the name of nominees on the white board.
6. The electors attending in person submitted their nominees to the Clerk via names written on paper slips, and those attending via Zoom sent the Clerk a private message stating their nominations.
7. Motion by Randy to close nominations, second by Vicki. All in favor, motion carried.
8. 16 people were nominated: Shannon Van Allen, Vicki Kosok, Rob Buntz, Dan Lerum, Dave Brassfield, Denay Kelly, Carrie Arens, Mike Olsen, Curt Brownell, Steve Dove, Goran Pesic, Tim Murray, John Hurtle, Chris Noel, Jeremy Marcks, and Randy Lesnau.
9. A vote was then taken to reduce the number of candidates to 6. Motion by Randy to close the second round of voting, second by Toni.
10. The 6 names with the most votes were: Shannon Van Allen, Vicki Kosok, Rob Buntz, Dan Lerum, Mike Olsen, and Carrie Arens.

- 11.** Motion by Randy to accept the nominations and certify them to the Clerk, second by Toni. All in favor, motion carried.
- 12.** Motion by Randy to destroy the ballots, second by Toni. All in favor, motion carried.
- 13.** Motion by Randy to adjourn the caucus, second by Vicki. All in favor. Caucus adjourned at 7:45.
