MINUTES

1. Chairperson Carrie Arens called the meeting to order at 4:05pm
2. **Roll call:** Carrie Arens, Mike Michaud, Pat Sandstrom, Goran Pesic, Misty Rustad
 - **Absent:** Danny Kircher
3. **Mobile Food Truck Ordinance**
 - Our attorney would like to see the fees included in the ordinance.
 - There was much discussion both for and against this ordinance and how it affects the Village.
 - Kim Seipel voiced his concern about the Village trying to limit what he can do on his property at the Country Stop.
 - Mike Michaud spoke about how it is the public interest to implement an ordinance such as this to try to regulate Mobile/Temporary Food trucks/stands.
 - It was noted that the Pickle Factory had purchased only one Mobile Food Truck Ordinance in 2020, but had 4 different food trucks throughout the summer in the parking lot which is Village Property.
 - Carrie made a motion to table the discussion until more research can be done, 2nd by Mike, all in favor, motion carried.
4. **Vacation Rental Ordinance** – Mike as for more time to review the ordinance before any recommendation be given to the Village Board.
 - Dan F stated that he spoke with VRBO and Air BNB and according to those 2 businesses, the rental places do not need a Sales Permit unless they rent it out on their own.
 - Carrie noted that through the research she has done, it appears that many municipalities are all “in the same boat” because the number vacation rentals have increased dramatically in the last couple of years.
 - Randy stressed that the Village wants to put this into place to try to protect the community and that these business need to also help pay for infrastructure, like everyone else.
 - Mike also mentioned that we need to look into current vacation rentals that are in commercially zoned areas.
5. **Adjourn** – Carrie made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Mike, all in favor, meeting adjourned at 5:02pm.
