ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING

Village of Pepin Municipal Building

Tuesday, June 1, 2021 at 4:30pm

MINUTES

1. Chairperson Carrie Arens called the meeting to order at 4:30pm.
2. **Roll Call** – Carrie Arens, Danny Kircher, Mike Michaud, Pat Sandstrom, Misty Rustad *clerk*
 - **Absent** – Goran Pesic
 - **Guest** – Ed Fernholz (rep for the Sportsman's Club)
3. **Meeting Minutes from 05/18/21** – **Motion:** Danny made a motion to approve, 2nd by Mike, all in favor, motion carried.
4. **Boat Launch Ordinance**
 - Sportsman's Club requested to have residents as defined as anyone on living in the Pepin Area School District which would be the 54759 and 54769 zip code.
 - People who just park in the specified area will need to pay the fee as well, just not people launching their boats.
 - Currently, there are approximately 16 parking spaces, if the landing is moved more towards the Pickle Factory, it will allow for more parking.
 - The parking lot is used by people who aren't using the landing. Examples: Pickle Factory customers, boat owners that dock their boat in the Marina, etc.
 - \$10 a day for parking regardless of using the boat landing.
 - Chief Van Alstine will be in charge of enforcing the parking.
 - **Changes made to the ordinance:**
 - **Name:** Sportsman's Landing Use Ordinance.
 - **Add** - Watercraft defined as: boats, canoes, kayaks, air boats, jet skis.
 - **Remove** – The canoe or kayak launch fee will be \$2 per watercraft.
 - **Add** - Permit must be displayed on the drivers' side of the dash or hanging from the rear-view mirror.
 - **Add** – Licensed Tournament Registration Fee - \$300 per tournament (excluding non-profit organizations)
 - A few small wording changes.
 - **Motion:** Danny made a motion to make changes to the ordinance before going to a public hearing, 2nd by Pat, all in favor, motion carried
 - Discussion on the map for the parking area. Will need to put signs up for the parking spots.
5. **Discussion on definition of Ordinance Committee** – **Motion:** Carrie made a motion to table the discussion until it can be looked into further, 2nd by Pat, all in favor, motion carried
6. **Adjourn** – **Motion:** Dan made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Pat, all in favor, meeting adjourned at 6:14pm.
