### MINUTES

1. Carrie called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.
2. **Roll Call** – Carrie Arens, Goran Pesic, Danny Kircher, Mike Michaud (via Zoom), Drew Adams clerk, Tom Latane(via Zoom), Dougie Padilla(via Zoom).
  - **Absent** – Pat Sandstrom
3. **Meeting Minutes from 07/29/21** – **Motion:** Mike made a motion to approve, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danny, all in favor, motion carried.
4. **Discussion/work on sewer ordinance-** There is currently no sewer ordinance in place, but it would be prudent to have one. Conversation currently tabled so Mike can work on a sewer rate ordinance, and he will let Carrie know when it is nearly complete so it can then be presented to the committee.
5. **Discussion/recommendation on Ordinance #92.03 (A) (13)-** Recommendation to remove the language pertaining to snow, and keep the ordinance confined to the topic of yard waste only. **Motion:** Carrie made a motion to approve, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Goran. All in favor, motion carried.
6. **Discussion/work on recodification. Due August 31, 2021.-** Discussion continued on the Legal Editorial Report. The following numbers pertain to American Legal Publishing Corporation's suggestions from the report:
  - 12.) Title XI 110.23- Application for liquor license fee will be updated from \$5.00 to \$30.00. Board previously approved the fee change, but ordinance was never updated. Other sections look good for now.
  - 16.) It was determined acceptable to use the Village's old code material in Chapter 10.
  - 17.) Left as is for now, will be addressed later.
  - 18.) Committee is okay changing statute number 66.62 to 66.0701.
  - 19.) Committee is okay changing statute number 66.60 to 66.0703 (12) and changing 66.62 to 66.0701 (2).
  - 20.) Leaving as is for now. Carrie will touch base with Police Chief for later review.
  - 21.) Leaving as is for now. Will be passed on to City Attorney for review.
  - 26.) Statute 66.12 has been renumbered 66.0114, and the citation will be revised accordingly.
  - 32.) As the DNR now oversees the removal of flammable liquid storage tanks, and there are concerns over it being in the wrong section, sections 95.02 and 95.03 will be referred to the City Attorney for review.
  - 35.) Statute references for Class A and Class B liquor licenses will need to be straightened out. Will seek clarification on wording.
  - 37.) 112.01- Carrie will look into this.
  - 49.) River Road Preservation 151.095 through 151.108- County Ordinance will be adopted.
