**Joint Meeting for Streets Committee and Planning Commission Meeting Minutes  
August 30, 2021, 4:00pm**

**1<sup>st</sup> order - Call to order: Randy K called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM**

**2<sup>nd</sup> order - Roll Call: Randy K, Toni R, Mike M, Tom L, Vicki, Danny K, Aaron K John H and Roy F**

- Absent – Paul R

**3<sup>th</sup> order – Discussion on Hwy 35 Snow Removal**

- Questions have been received regarding snow removal
- Where are snow banks created
- When are the streets plowed and how often
- Currently:
  - If the sidewalk meets the street (ne green grassy area) snow removal is not mandatory
  - If a grassy area separation exists, then snow removal is mandatory
  - Aaron shovels those area requiring manual shoveling and those areas reported as NOT cleared by the resident
  - Pine is a direct street and crossing for school students
- Mike M suggested contracting the snow removal and haul off
- Toni R asked if only having to handle to required areas such as the school route would lessen the burden on the Streets People
  - Aaron responded yes
- Mike M made a motion to table
  - Vicki 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion
  - None opposed
- Roy asked about the sidewalk at 2<sup>nd</sup> and Main – there’s a step in the sidewalk rather than being flat
  - Aaron will paint yellow for visibility

**4<sup>th</sup> order – Discussion/Action on Requests for Decks on Village Right of Ways**

- **A – 400 1<sup>st</sup> Street** – recommended approval for commercial deck on the Village right of way
  - Roy presented the owners request and plans
  - Roy also stated WI statutes do allow for temporary permitting – if the state or municipality should want the use back then the owner must remove the structure(s)
  - Owner offer to replace the old sidewalk
  - Current plan is in the path of recently added drainage run offs and could impede the results achieved b the work
  - Drainage is currently 6’ from the building

- Proposed deck would extend 10' from the building
- Joint Committee denied the request as presented
  - Impacts on drainage and snow removal
- **B – 403 2<sup>nd</sup> Street** - recommended approval for private deck on the Village right of way
  - Roy presented the owners request and plans
    - Owner had already commenced work and was ordered to stop pending approval of the permit
  - Owner wants the replacement deck larger than the old deck – back and side decks
    - Owner states posts are in same place as old posts
  - The area for the side deck is denied as presented
  - The area for the back deck is approved as presented (not in right of way)
