

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
**VILLAGE OF PEPIN BOARD OF TRUSTEES**  
**IN THE VILLAGE OF PEPIN, WISCONSIN**

Notice is Hereby Given that the Village of Pepin Board of trustees will hold a public hearing on **January 12<sup>th</sup> 2022 at 7:00 p.m.** for the purpose of providing the community a reasonable opportunity to comment upon:

**1)** The creation of a Tourism Commission Ordinance pursuant to Section 66.0615(1m)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and

**2)** Modification of the Village Room Tax ordinance, Ch 112, Section 112.04, Division of Room tax Revenues, to change the Room Tax distribution percentage amount from the current ordinance requirement that Eighty percent of Room Tax receipts should be used for promotion of tourism in the village, to 70 percent.

The purpose of the Tourism Commission is to manage the use of that portion of the Room Tax funds collected by the Village under Ch. 112 of the Village Code of Ordinances that are required to be spent on Tourism Promotion and Tourism Development, including capital improvement projects, within the Village.

The meeting will be held at the Pepin Village Hall, located at 508 Second Street. All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to express their views on the proposed creation of the Tourism Commission, and the proposed ordinance regarding thereof, and modification to Ch 112 regarding the proposed change to the Division of Room Tax Revenues.

A copy of the Ordinances will be available for viewing in the offices of the Village Clerk at the Pepin Village Hall, located at 508 Second Street during normal business hours, and will be provided upon request.
